Students hear a word and select the letter that makes the vowel sound in the middle of the word.

MATERIALS: Chalkboard/chalk, vowel cards

- 1 Write the name of each participating student on the board.
- 2 Distribute a set of vowel cards to each student.
- 3 Ask the group,
Which of your vowels makes the sound in the middle of this word? When I tell you, hold up the letter. The word is ____. Then say a CVC word (e.g., cat, met, hid, pot, rug).
- 4 When told to, each student selects a vowel and holds it up.
- 5 On the board, mark one point for each student holding up the correct vowel. Review the answer with students.
- 6 After 10 rounds, students with the most points win.



PREPARATION OF MATERIALS: Print a set of Vowel Cards for each student. Cut the cards apart. Follow the directions for play.
