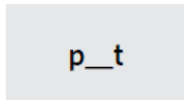
## GK-38 Middle Vowel Swap

Students practice substituting the middle vowel in words to make real and made-up words.

**MATERIALS:** Plastic/magnetic vowels, index cards, marker

1 Write different sets of beginning and ending letters on index cards, one set per card. Make sure the space between letters is large enough to place a plastic vowel.



2 Place plastic vowels on a table. Students can have their own set of vowels or share with a partner.

3 Give each student a beginning and ending letters card.

4 Students add vowels to the middle of their card to form words. Students read their words and tell whether they're real or made-up.

EXAMPLE:

Real and Made-Up Word Combinations				
pet	pit	put	pot	pat
bet	bit	but	bot	bat
fet	fit	fut	fot	fat
set	sit	sut	sot	sat
pep	pip	pup	pop	pap
ten	tin	tun	ton	tan
lep	lip	lup	lop	lap



**PREPARATION OF MATERIALS:** Print one set of Vowel Cards for each student. Print one set of Word Cards for students to work on during the lesson. Cut the cards apart. Follow the directions for play.
